Student Volunteer Program

The Kingston Humane Society invites students ages 14 and up who are looking to fulfill their high school community service hours to apply for a volunteer position with us. Candidates are required to submit a completed application as well as a short 3 paragraph essay stating why you would like to volunteer with the Kingston Humane Society.

Successful candidates will demonstrate the following;

- Love and concern for the wellbeing of our animals
- Willingness to help
- Commit to an extra 10 "goodwill" volunteer hours on top of your required 40 hrs (your 40 hrs will not be signed off until your "goodwill" hours are complete)
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Punctuality and excellent attendance rate
- Respect for staff, fellow volunteers and visitors

All successful candidates must attend an orientation session as well as a specialized training session for specific volunteer positions prior to beginning their volunteer commitment. Parents must accompany students to the orientation session. Parents will not be required to attend volunteer hours with student.

The following volunteer positions will be available for student volunteers for the February 2017 to July 2017 period (Deadline to apply January 1st. 2017):

- Cat Cuddling – this will be the main volunteer task
- Occasionally helping out in the front office (cleaning, organizing, etc... as required by staff)
- Occasionally helping out at special events
